

- Report of Activities

Activities of NSS unit St. Pauls College, aligned to 'Parivarthan' (2021-2022)

On 22nd and23rd June 2021 NSS Unit No:38 of St. Paul's college, Kalamassery in coordination with Govt of Kerala, Dept. of women and child development and ICDS, Edapally, conducted a **Webinar on the Topic 'ANEMIA: PREVENTION AND CONTROL'**. The aim of the program was to create awareness about low level haemoglobin in women and children.

NSS unit 38 of St Paul's College Kalamassery conducted an online workshop based on gender awareness programme in association with child development department. It was a two-day program, conducted on 22nd and 23rd July, 2021. From 21st July to 26th July NSS unit no:38 of St Paul's College Kalamassery celebrated one week long anti-drug campaign namely 'Nasha mukht Bharat' and various programs and competitions were conducted as a part of this campaign. NSS unit no. 38 of St. Paul's College Kalamassery and social outreach in association with Rotary club cosmos and Sanjeevanam Ayurveda hospital conducted free covid-19 vaccination drive on 3rd September 2021. As a part of NSS day the volunteers cleaned up the herbal garden and surroundings of the college on 24-09-2021, 28-09-2021, 29-09-2021 and 30-09-2021. In commemoration of the separation of our NSS family member Sanjay Antony, the children of the Edathala SOS children's village were given learning materials called 'MCMan MDDOMO'. The learning materials were distributed by our NSS volunteers themselves. Books, pencils, sharpeners, rubber, crayons and sketches all of these were collected by our NSS volunteers from their departments and donated to the children of SoS children's Village. On 24,28,29, and 30 September NSS Unit no.38 of St. Paul's college, Kalamassery distributed meal parcels as part of the NSS Week celebrations. 
Teachers' Day – with free vaccines
