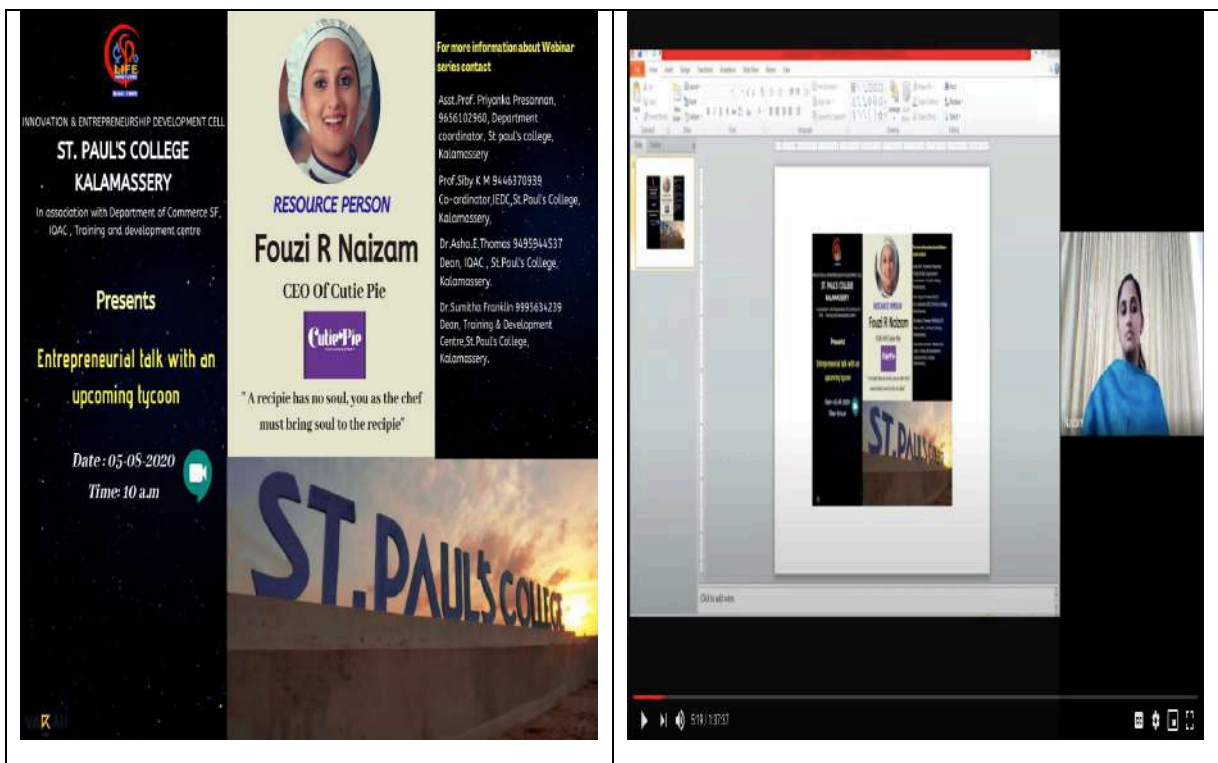

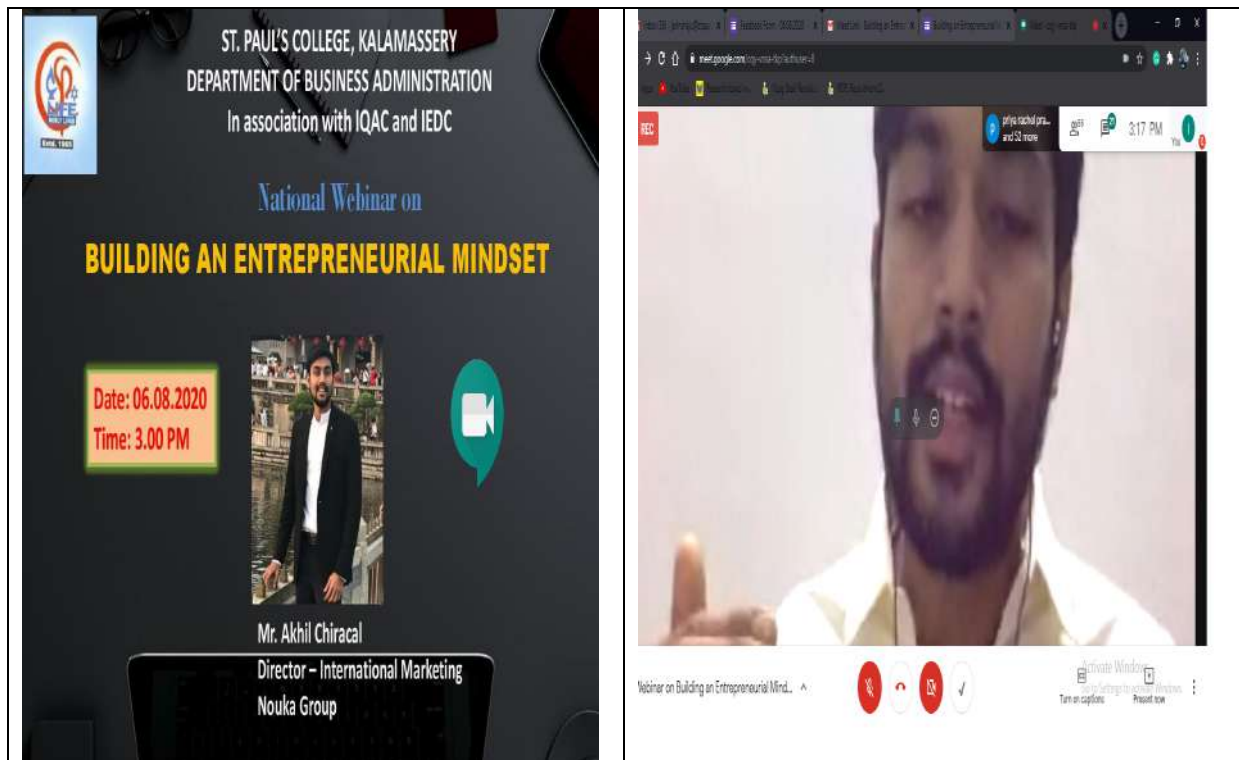

10. National Level Online Quiz

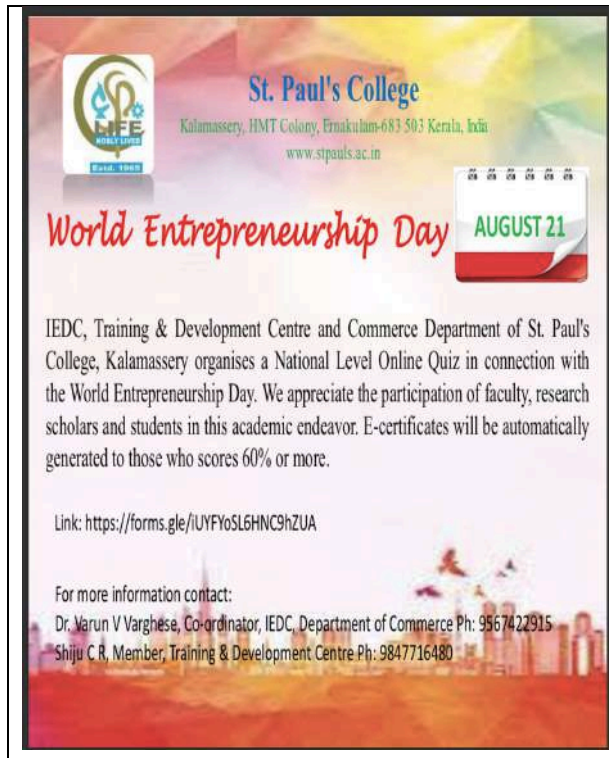

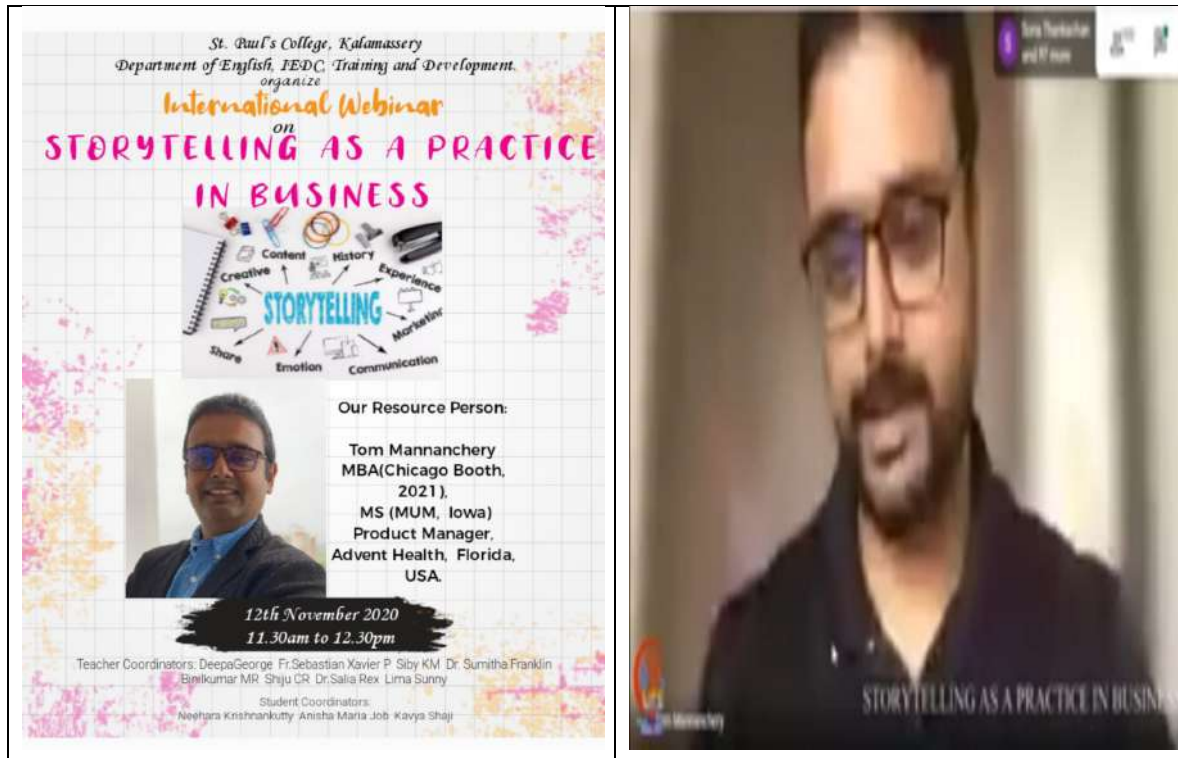

Storytelling has an important role to play in the life of an entrepreneur. The webinar was an eye opener into the need for developing the skill of artful storytelling to convince the customer.



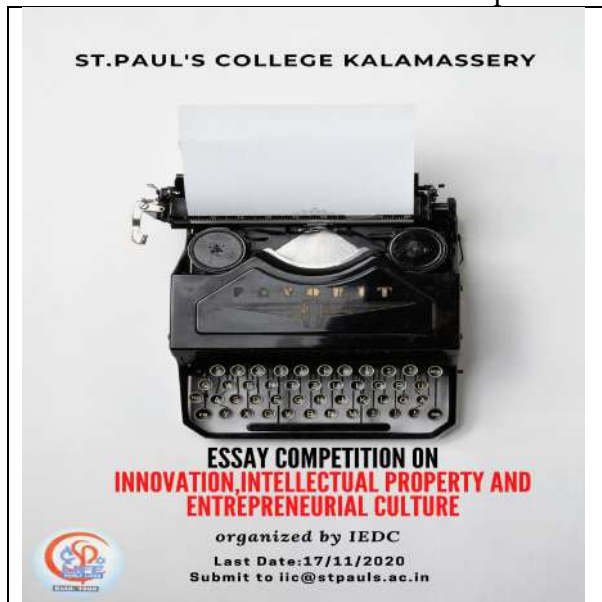
