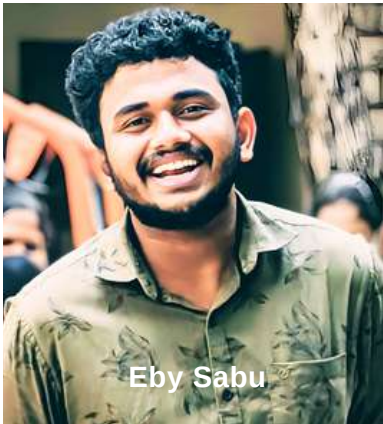

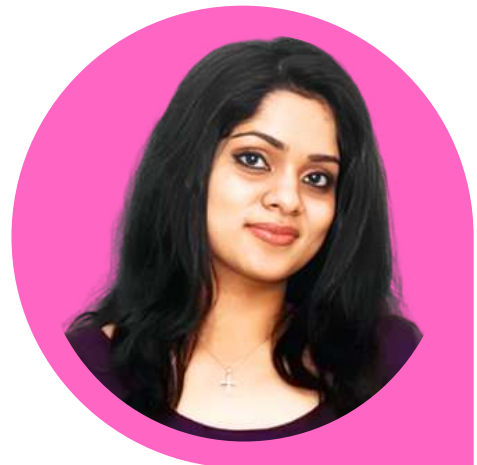
Taksha'24

Workshop on Flutter and Python

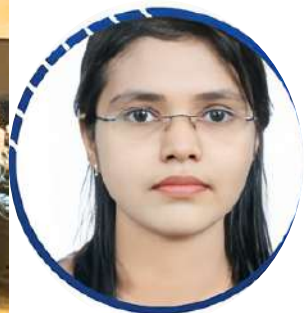
Equal Stride

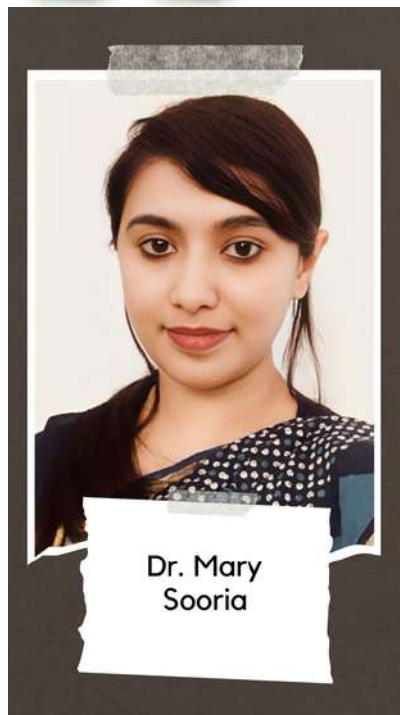
