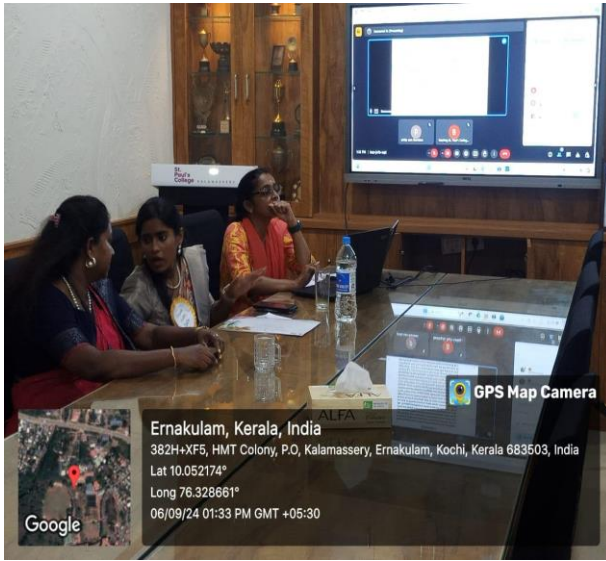

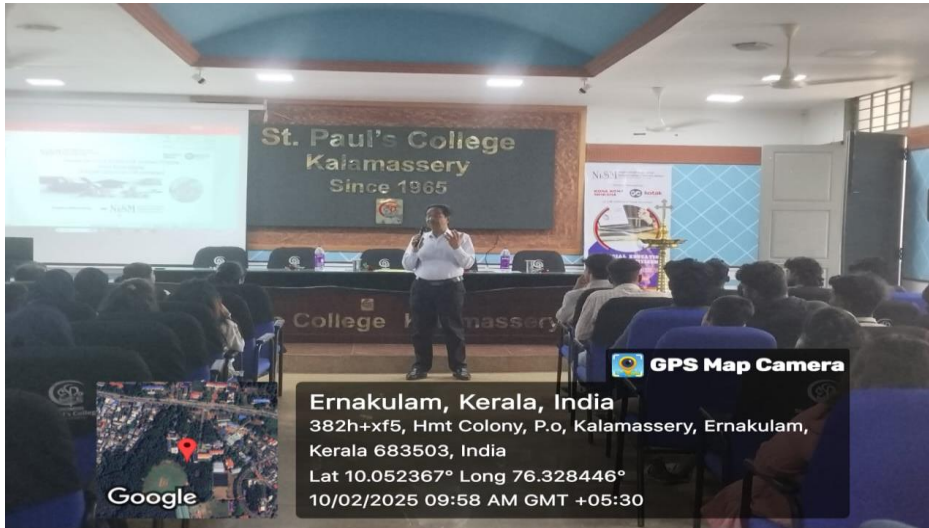
## **TWO-DAY INVESTMENT AWARENESS PROGRAMME IN** **ASSOCIATION WITH - NISM**
