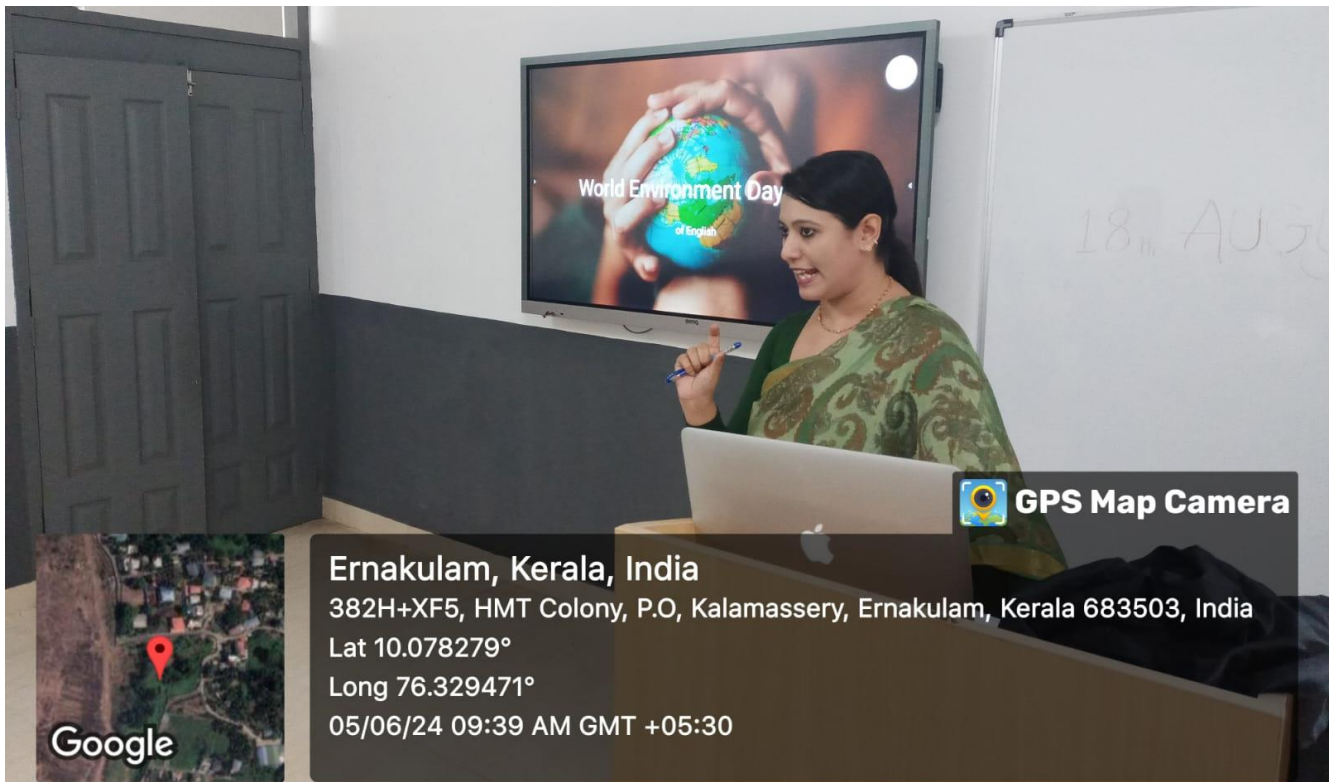

June

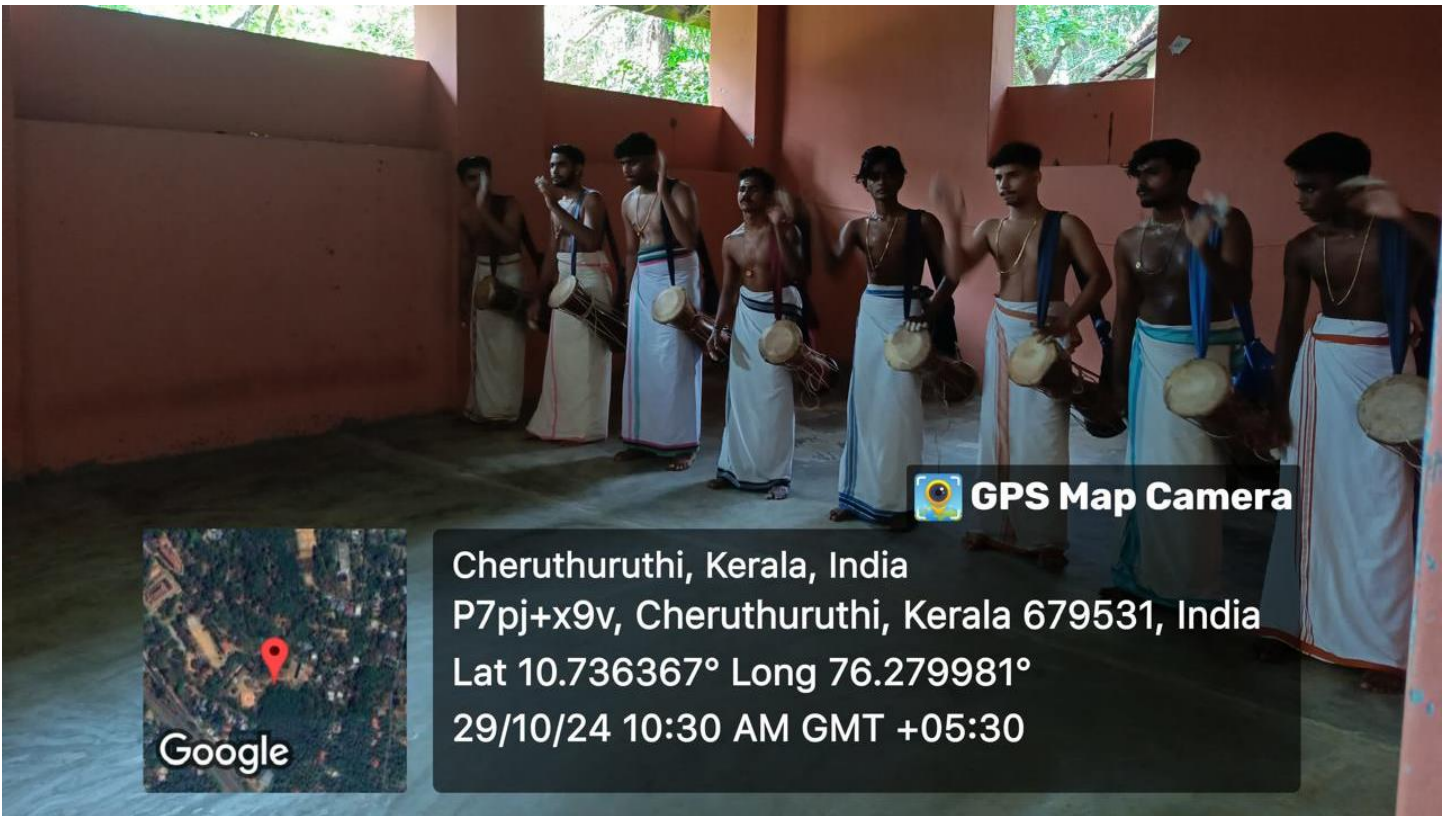

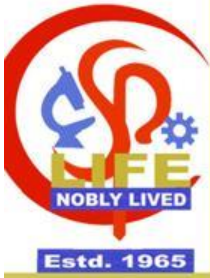


July

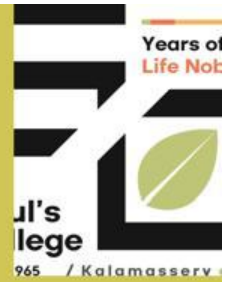

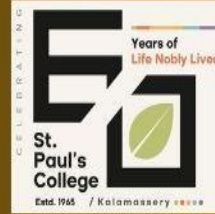
February

- The tenure of fellowship is five years and it commences from the date of declaration of NET result, i.e., **22-02-2025** (or) from the date of admission under Ph.D. (or) from the date of joining Ph.D. programme, whichever is later.
