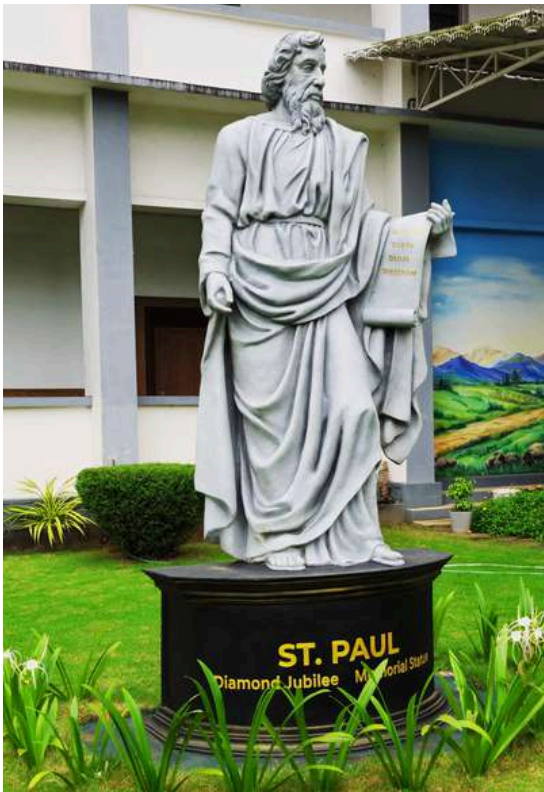


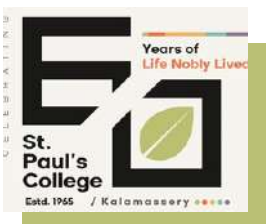

International Seminar on Sustainable Approach to a Greener Future



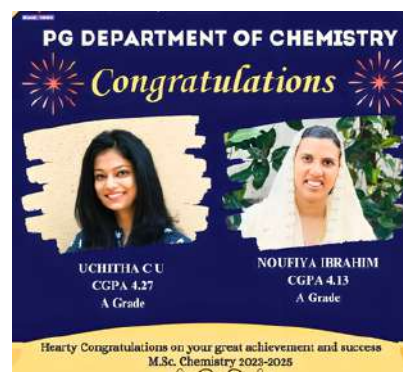

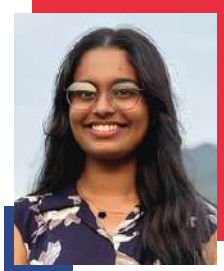
