Campus Tour

Overall, the session emphasized how both mutual funds and ETFs are suitable options for different types of investors depending on their financial goals and risk appetite. 55 students participated in the session.

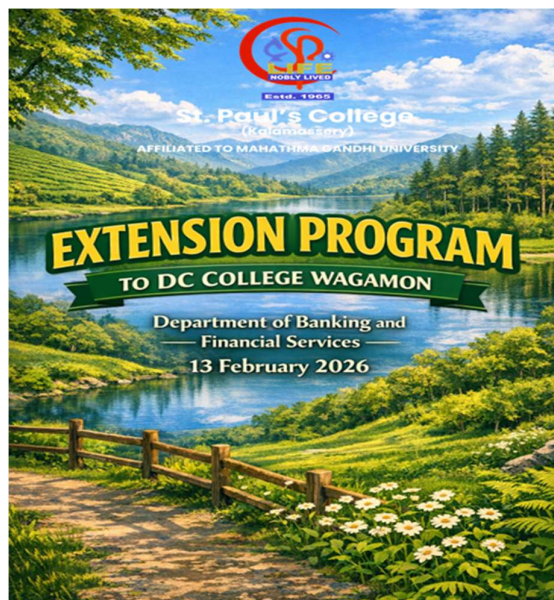
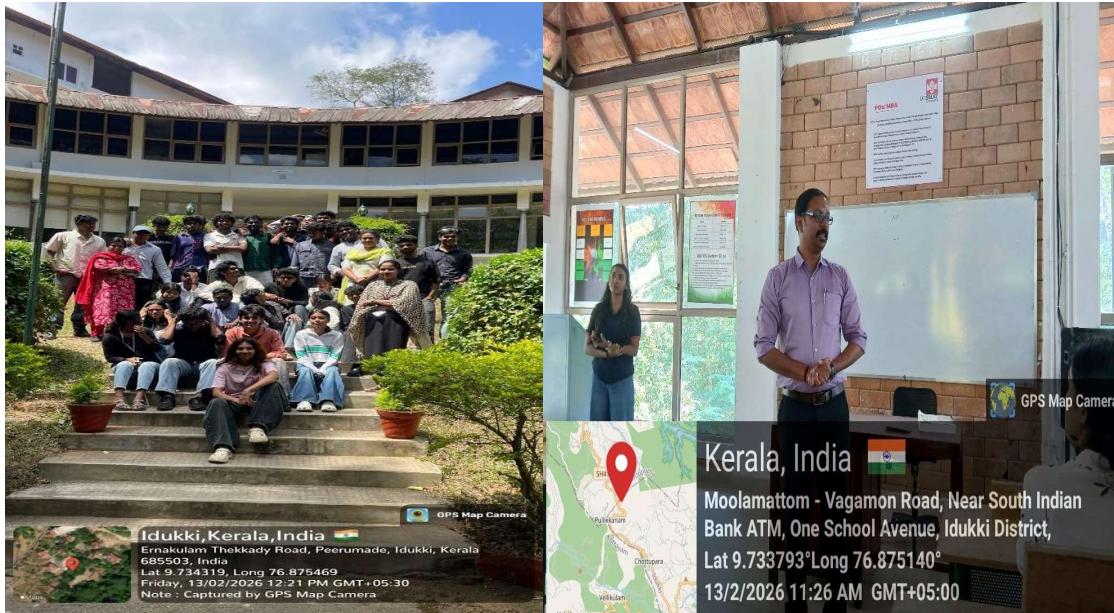
Workshop On Emerging Trends In Commodity Derivatives
