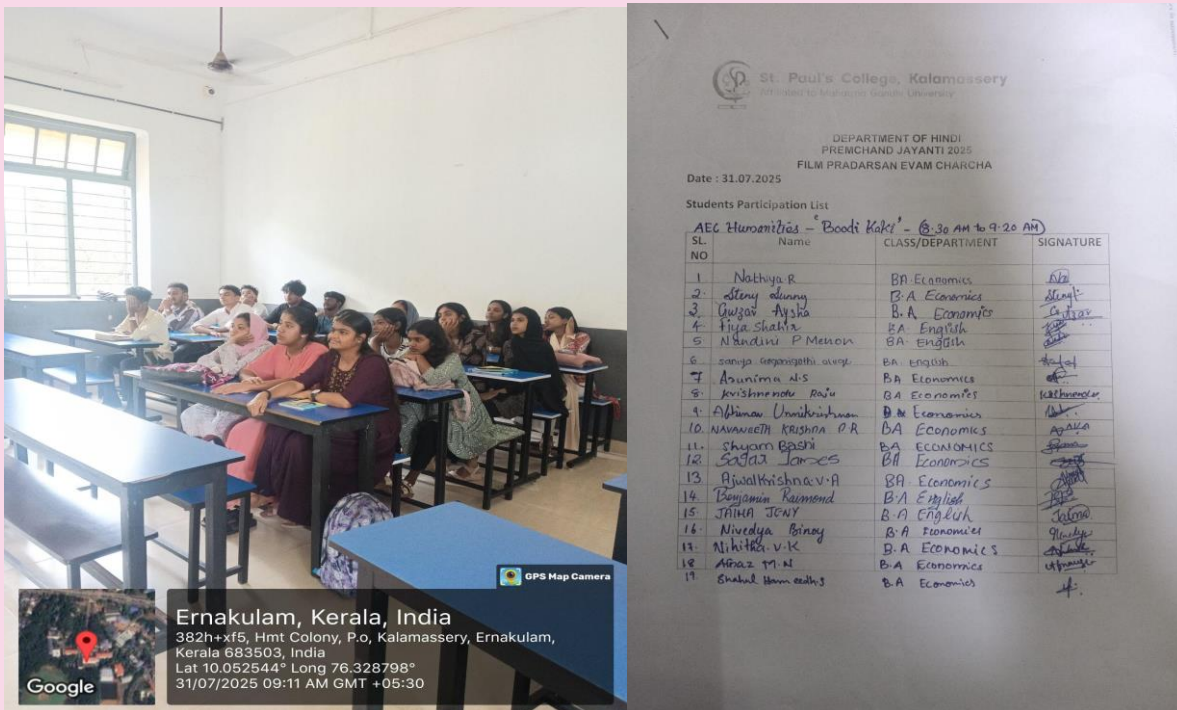
Session I: First Semester AEC Humanities Students

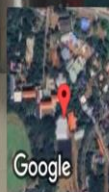
