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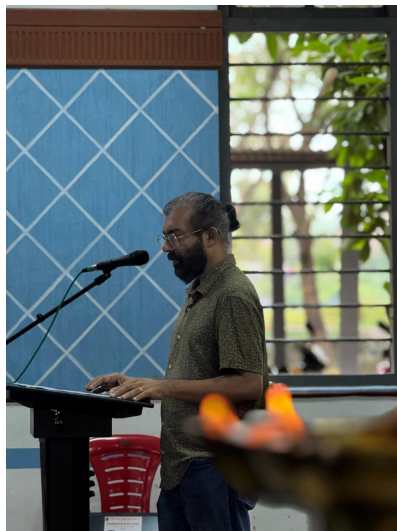
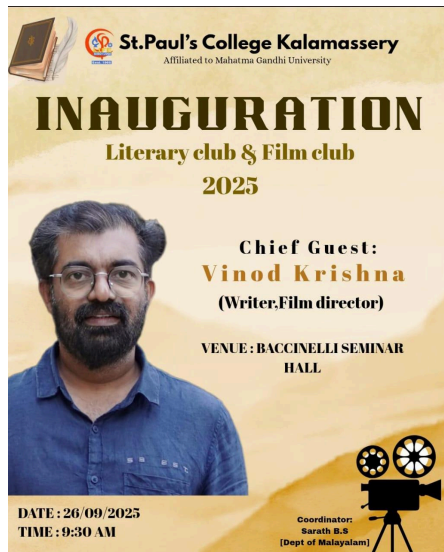
Reading Day Celebration

The film festival provided an enriching learning experience and successfully complemented the academic objectives of the syllabus.



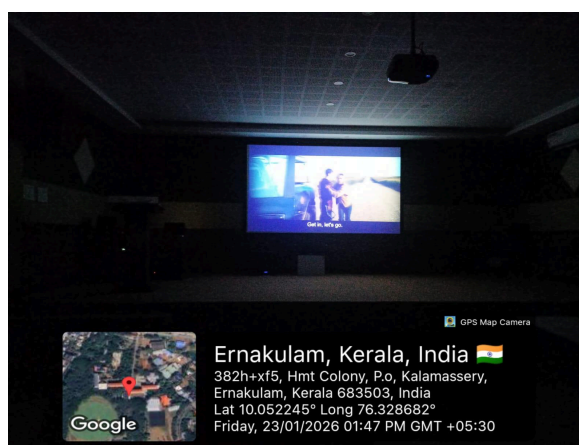

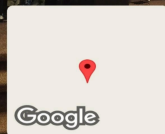
